

Boon Lay Station

Boon Lay emerged as an important hub in Jurong during the 1980s. The name is derived from one of Singapore's early pioneers, ① Mr Chew Boon Lay, who owned extensive pepper, gambier and ② rubber plantations in the area during the early 20th century.

A notable landmark in Boon Lay is the ③ Tuas Pek Kong Keng Temple, founded in the 1940s and continues to serve the community to the present day.

In 2000, ④ ST Engineering acquired Chartered Industries of Singapore (CIS) through its subsidiary, ST Automotive, and the merged entity was named ST Kinetics. CIS gained recognition for producing Singapore's first domestically manufactured ammunition, minted coins and later ventured into the designing of weapons.

(5) Boon Lay Shopping Centre was the first shopping and residential complex built by Jurong Town Corporation (JTC) in Jurong and was completed in the late 1970s.
